**TOWNSHIP TICKET**

**Orleans Township Levy**

Shall Orleans Township be allowed to levy a property tax not to exceed 10 cents per one hundred dollars of taxable valuation in the excess of the limits prescribed by law until the fiscal year 2021, for the purpose of general operations of the township, Cemetery and Library.

A vote “**Yes**” on the issue grants authority to Orleans Township to exceed statutory

A vote “**No**” does not grant such authority to Orleans Township

**Oxford Township Levy**

Shall the governing body of the incorporated municipality impose a reallocation of up to fifty percent (50%) of the one-half percent (1/2%) additional Sales and Use Tax established on May 21, 2012 as the Village Improvement Fund, and became effective January 1, 2013 for the use of assisting in the funding of Contract with the Furnas County Sheriff for the Village of Oxford, Nebraska commencing on December 1, 2016.

A vote “**For**” reallocation of the ½ percent sales and use tax

**REFERENDUM ORDERED BY PETITION OF THE PEOPLE – REFERENDUM No. 426**

The purpose of Legislative Bill 268, passed by the First Session of the 104<sup>th</sup> Nebraska Legislature in 2015, is to eliminate the penalty and change the maximum penalty for the crime of murder in the first degree to life imprisonment.

A vote to “**RETAIN**” will eliminate the death penalty and change the maximum penalty for the crime of murder in the first degree to life imprisonment by retaining Legislative Bill 268, passed in 2015 by the First Session of the 104<sup>th</sup> Nebraska Legislature.

A vote to “**REPEAL**” will keep the death penalty as a possible penalty for the crime of murder in the first degree by repealing Legislative Bill 268, passed in 2015 by the First Session of the 104<sup>th</sup> Nebraska Legislature.
