This position includes a variety of responsibilities including felony, misdemeanor and infraction prosecution, child support enforcement, mental health commitment, juvenile court, civil litigation and coroner duties. Additional duties include covering on-call periods to answer after-hours legal questions from law enforcement, attending bi-weekly County Board meetings, and other duties as defined by Nebraska statutes.
